# BELPRE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY

## REGISTRATION & TUITION FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Although Belpre Christian Academy is a ministry of CALVARY COMMUNITY CHURCH, the school is chiefly dependent upon the tuition payments of students and the gifts of friends for operating expenses. All contributions are tax-deductible.

**\$90 New Student (non-refundable)**

**\$50 Re-enrollment**

**\$5 K-12th Insurance**

**\$50 Maintenance Fee**

**\$12.50 BCSO Dues**

### **PACE FEES:**

**\$90 PACES per semester (1st—12th) per student**

**\$75 PACES per year (Kindergarten)**

PACEs will be charged at \$3 each. Repeat PACEs will cost \$5 each. Students use a PACE for each subject, which will last approximately 3 weeks—depending on the advancement of the child. Approximate monthly use should be 5-6 PACES.

### **TUITION**

**FIRST STUDENT—\$1650 per year—10 MONTHS @ \$165**

**SECOND STUDENT—\$1300 per year—10 MONTHS @ \$130**

**THIRD STUDENT—\$1150 per year—10 MONTHS @ \$115**

**K4 PROGRAM & KINDERGARTEN—\$1650 per year—10 MONTHS @ \$165**

TUITION PAYMENTS MAY BE MADE AS FOLLOWS:

- A. ONE YEARLY PAYMENT—A 5% discount will be given if payment is made by August 15th.
- B. TWO SEMESTER PAYMENTS—Payments are due beginning with the First Quarter & Third Quarter.
- C. TEN MONTHLY PAYMENTS—Payments begin August 1st and are due on the FIRST DAY of each month. The final payment is due May 1st. If your billing begins after the August 1st date, your last payment is due June 1st. (Payments will total the full year of Tuition)

New students beginning during the First Semester of the school year will be charged a full tuition amount in June. Those beginning during the Second Semester of the year will be charged 1/2 of a months tuition in June.

Financial arrangements will be made for those who qualify.

All prices are subject to change.

## ATTENDANCE POLICY

### Statement of Expectation

Regular school attendance is required by law. Regular and punctual attendance at Belpre Christian Academy is expected and required. Frequent absenteeism is a major cause of poor academic progress. Continual tardiness is disruptive, and only puts your student further behind. Graduation from BCA requires more than just completing the required PACE work. Attendance is a mandatory requirement, and parents should make every effort to have their children in regular attendance at the appointed times.

### Absenteeism

Due to Compulsory Attendance laws, students who are absent or tardy excessively may be considered truant. Absences are not considered excused or unexcused. The importance of attending school, maintaining the PACE work, and valuing the BCA education should motivate all students to be at school. Students who accumulate an excess of 12 absences per school year may only be considered for promotion to the next grade level IF the following 4 requirements\*\* for absences are met:

\*\*If your student will be absent –

Parent verification must be made by phone call to the school at 740-423-7741 by 9:00AM. No Text or Messenger or Remind messages will be accepted as notification.

A written or typed note must be presented the morning the student returns to school.

Students will have 2 days in which to complete, score, and correct all missed PACE work for each day student is absent.

If your student is absent 1 day, they must have all work completed within the next 2 days; if your student is absent 2 days, they must have all work completed within the next 4 days; etc.

Students that document absences due to sickness will be required to have a doctor's excuse after three per quarter.

Students who accumulate 15 absences per school year will not be promoted to the next grade level. Extenuating circumstances will be handled on an individual basis.

### Tardiness/Early Dismissals

Each student is expected to be in the classroom by 8:15AM. School is dismissed at 3:00PM (Kindergarten students are dismissed at 12 Noon). Tardies and early dismissals will be considered as follows: 3 tardies = 1 absence; 3 early dismissals = 1 absence. Please make every effort to be on time and schedule all doctor, dentist, etc. appointments outside of school hours.

If a student is present at school a total of 4 hours, they will be considered present for that day – tardy and early dismissal rules still apply. Anything less than 4 hours will be considered an absence.

## STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God. We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons—Father, Son, & Holy Spirit.

We believe in the Deity of the Lord Jesus Christ, in His conception by the Holy Spirit and His birth by the virgin Mary, in His sinless life, in His miracles, vicarious & atoning death, in His bodily resurrection, ascension to the right hand of the Father, and His personal return in power & glory.

We believe in the ministry of the Holy Spirit in the life of the believer and the Church. In the life of the unsaved He convicts of sin, righteousness, and judgment to come. In the life of the believer, He cleanses, fills, and empowers for service.

We believe that salvation is wholly of Grace, but conditioned solely on repentance toward God, and acceptance of Christ by faith. When the sinner has met these requirements, God justifies him and regenerates him. Regeneration is the impartation of divine life, affecting a change in the believer's nature. By the operation of the Holy Spirit through the Word, he is given disposition to obey God. This experience is witnessed to by the Holy Spirit. Justification is a judicial act absolving from punishment and restoring to divine favor.

Sanctification is what the Spirit of God does in the soul in carrying on & perfecting the work of grace begun in regeneration.

We believe in the literal, Premillennial return of Jesus Christ, the subsequent rapture of the Church, the eternal bliss of the redeemed, and the eternal damnation of the lost.

We believe that man was created by an immediate act of God and not by a process of evolution; that he was created in the image & likeness of God, possessing personality & holiness; and that he is a free moral agent possessing the power of choice, and that the purpose of his creation was to glorify God.

We believe in the Biblical teaching about the fall of man; that because of this fall, death passed upon all men and sin entered the world. Therefore, condemnation rests upon him, and he is forever lost, except he be born again.

We believe that the Christian ordinances are outward rites appointed by Christ, to be administered in each church, not as a means of salvation, but as visible signs as the facts and realities of salvation.

We believe in water Baptism, and that it is to be administered as soon as possible following confession of faith in Christ. Immersion is the only Bible mode.

We believe that the Lord's Supper is an ordinance instituted by Christ for observance by His followers until He returns. It consists in partaking of the emblems of bread & wine, and symbolizes the death & suffering of Christ for the remission of sins, and our continual dependence upon Him for sustenance. The Lord's table should be open to all that are in right relationship with God, regardless of denomination.

We believe that marriage is a sacred institution ordained of God in the time of man's innocence and that it is a mutual union of one man & one woman and morally binding as long as both shall live; and therefore, it cannot be dissolved at will, nor should it be dissolved by decree of civil tribunal, except on evidence that one party is guilty of adultery.

We believe that the Scriptural teaching concerning the financing of the Lord's work is through the tithes and offerings of God's people.

We endeavor to develop patriotism: the love & loyal support of one's country. Including attachment to its land & people, admiration for its customs & traditions, and to its well-being; a feeling of oneness & membership in the nation.
